On Thursday, February 29, 2024, Governor McMaster signed a bill declaring the first Monday in March “Water Professionals Day”. The day is designed to recognize and celebrate the water, wastewater, and stormwater employees - the people that keep the water flowing into our homes. Thank you to Matthew and Brooke Glenn and the contractors used by the town for all your hard work for the Town of Sharon! The first official water professionals day will take place on Monday, **March 4, 2024**.



We will Spring Forward Saturday night **March 9th**, **Daylight Savings Time begins March 10th**. This is a good time to change the batteries in your smoke detectors and other home safety devices. Homes that use wood or natural gas for fuel should also have at least one carbon monoxide detector.



The first day of Spring begins on **March 19th**, while tidying up your yards and planting those new flowers how about making sure that your address numbers are clearly posted so that they are clearly visible in day or night from the roadway. Remove any weeds, debris or overgrowth that may have accumulated over the winter.
