- **4. Blocked Drainage areas State Maintenance in process:** Town Roads, Culverts, Ditch lines. **Contacts** Todd Cook District Maintenance Eng, Jason Johnston, Michael Sandifer. The town has requested assistance from SC DOT for our drainage issues. Many of the town culverts, ditches and drain lines are completely or nearly completely stopped up, not allowing the water to flow from the streets. **Reminder residents:** Please keep your yard debris picked up, so it does not enter the roadway hence entering the drainage system causing blockage. If your property has a ditched area that allows the water to flow to a drainage area, please do not barricade or block for any reason with tree limbs, construction debris, rocks, etc. The water must be allowed to flow from the streets and properties to enter the drainage system.
