On Tuesday, November 19th Sharon VFD went through an Insurance Services Office or better known as (ISO) evaluation. ISO collects information from communities regarding their structure fire suppression capabilities. This evaluation takes place about every five years. Each fire department is given a Public Protection Classification rating from 1 to 10 that insurance companies use to set insurance premiums that businesses and homeowners pay to cover potential losses. With 1 being the best and 10 being no protection coverage. Currently Sharon is a class 4 and has been for many years. Some of the things that departments are evaluated on are communications, amount of water available for a fire, staffing, equipment, and personnel training, along with many other record keeping requirements. Areas outside of five miles from a fire station are generally considered not protected and homeowners pay a higher premium.
